



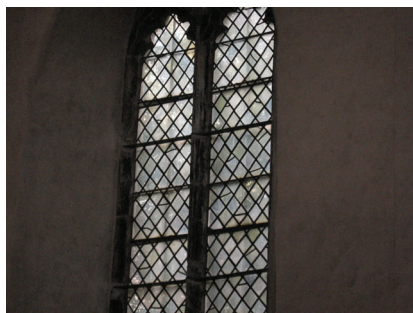
## Pattern I-spy

2. This is near the top of a Gothic (pointed) arch.



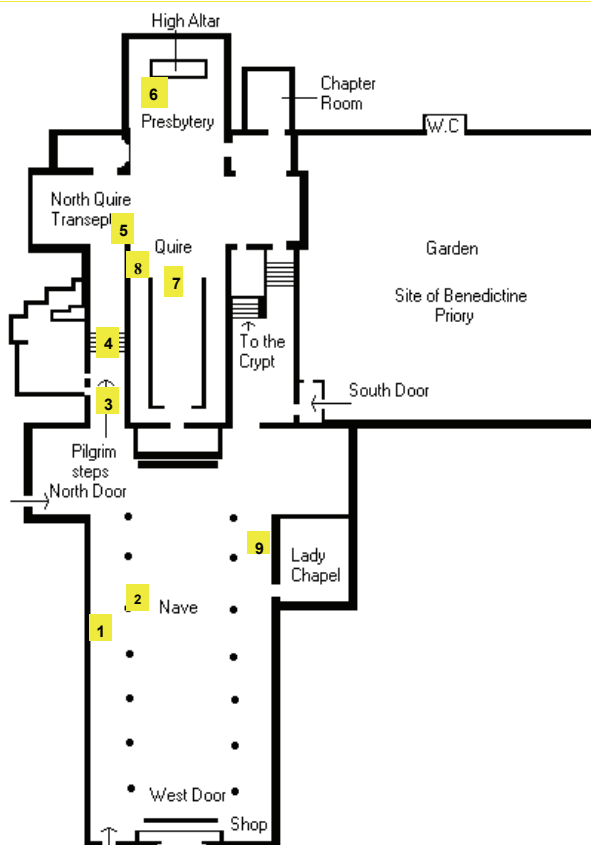
